



At the age of 19 – Louise Wayte (Pearson) and a friend moved to Port Alberni to start a business – FINISHING TOUCHES.

40 Years ago (IN FACT FINISHING TOUCHES WILL BE CELEBRATING THEIR 40<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF BUSINESS LATER NEXT MONTH!).

They set up a 450 square foot store in the 'brand new' Alberni Mall

They pioneered 'Aesthetics' in the Alberni Valley. Few people even knew what the word meant let alone what the business would be.

The Economic Development office of the day tried to deter these two young women. Fortunately...., the women prevailed – after much lobbying to the Mayor at the time – Jim Robertson

18 months after opening the two women nearly doubled their space in the mall and then....they doubled it again moving to a 1500 square foot location in 'Center-Court.'







The early 80's was a tremendously difficult time for women in business, exacerbated by the downturn in the forest industry.

They persevered

Louise decided to buy-out Carolyn's shares in the 1980's and then with her dear husband Mike, they went out on a limb to build their own store on Elizabeth Street

Today Louise is extremely proud of her 40 years in business and thoroughly enjoys working with a dynamic team of women – 8 women who have contributed immensely to the success of the business.

Two of the 8 include Caroline and Jane who have been with Louise for OVER 30 YEARS!
